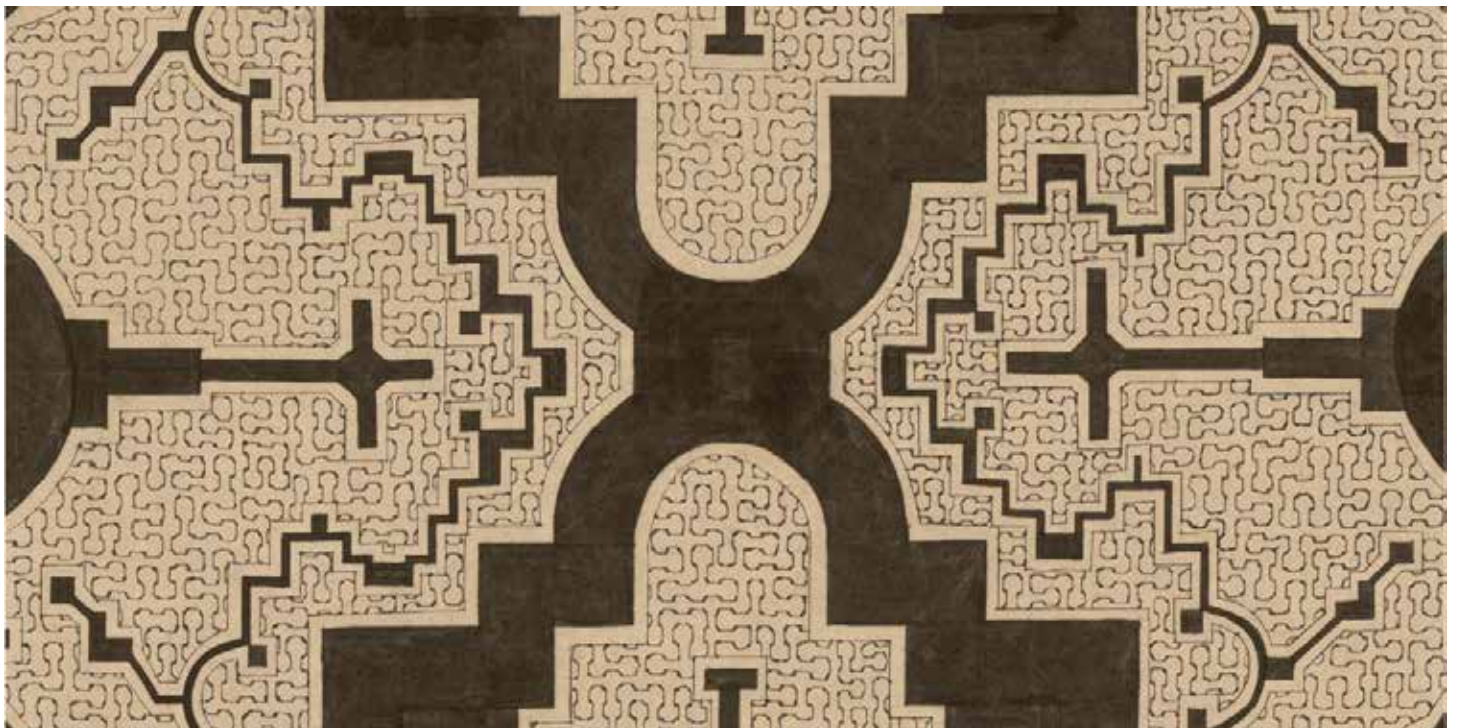

How to get to ardez from Zurich

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1. Upon arrival at Zurich Airport, follow the signs to the train station located inside the airport.
2. At the station, use a ticket machine or visit a ticket counter:
 - At the machine: select your language, tap "Buy Ticket," and enter Ardez as your final destination.
 - At the counter: simply ask for a ticket to Ardez, and staff will assist you.The total journey takes approximately 2 hours and 45 minutes.
3. With your ticket, proceed to the platform and board a train heading toward Chur. You will transfer at Landquart.
4. In Landquart, change platforms and take the train toward Scuol-Tarasp, which is the final leg of your journey.

After approximately 45 minutes, you will arrive at Ardez station.

About the Engadine

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The Engadine is a high Alpine valley in southeastern Switzerland with around 25,000 inhabitants. The Lower Engadine is especially known for its stunning natural beauty, featuring forests, deep valleys, and peaceful rural villages that have preserved a strong regional identity.

This region maintains a unique cultural heritage, including the continued use of the Romansh language. Local communities balance nature, agriculture, and tradition, while villages such as Ardez, Ftan, and Guarda are known for their historic houses decorated with Sgraffito—a distinctive artistic technique deeply rooted in the culture of the Graubünden region.
